"Continuance of Supply" (2013 review)

Option C: Continuance of supply by lines with no expiry date.

This option is the simplest, the easiest to adopt, and would be the least costly to implement.

Power lines have always crossed rural areas in order to bring electricity supplies to urban areas where the vast majority of consumers now live. A perceived subsidy of urban to rural consumers is more than offset by the use of rural land to supply access for power lines serving urban areas.
