Option A/B - continuance of supply expires

I query what will happen to "low users" under these options. As I understand it, Government policy requires all electricity suppliers to provide a "low user" costing option - I am one such user. Post 2013, if the obligation to supply expires, will it be possible for line companies to decide it is uneconomic to continue supply to "low users"? So, on a given urban street, those houses who are "low users" have their supply stopped, but the rest of the street continues to receive supply? Could that happen? If so, it makes a mockery of the Government's policies on electricity efficiency and the benefits of "low users".
